22 Vanguard Award, and he is a National Hispanic Recognized Scholar;
23 he holds a first degree black belt in the Korean martial art of Kuk
24 Sool Won; and

1 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Puckett's dedication to excellence and
2 his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy
3 to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with
4 pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

6 Legislature hereby congratulate Marcus Edward Puckett on achieving
7 the rank of Eagle Scout and extend to him sincere best wishes for
8 continued success and happiness; and, be it further
