15 distinguished herself through her participation in numerous civic
16 groups, including the Fort Worth Transportation Authority, the
17 Minority Leaders and Citizens' Council, the Fort Worth Metropolitan
18 Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Sickle Cell Disease Association
19 of America, and she has been active in Greater First Missionary
20 Baptist Church; moreover, she received the 2009 Living Legend Award
21 for Community Service from *La Vida News*; and

23 committed to the Eta Phi Beta ideals of sisterhood, leadership, and
