- 9 switchboard, and working as floor hostesses; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Today more than 300 men and women belong to the
- 11 auxiliary, with at least half of them serving as regular
- 12 volunteers; they work in all areas of the hospital and also offer
- 13 rides to and from the parking lot by golf cart; and
- WHEREAS, In addition to carrying out their day-to-day work,
- 15 members raise money to help pay for hospital equipment and other
- 16 items; over the last four decades, they have collected more than \$1
- 17 million through gift shop sales, hospital vending machines, bake
- 18 sales, and an annual benefit concert; moreover, the auxiliary
- 19 provides six college scholarships for local youth; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Dedicated to the health of the community, the
- 21 auxiliary works with the Gulf Coast Regional Blood Center to
- 22 sponsor monthly blood drives; these events have been recognized
- 23 numerous times for the high numbers of donations they are able to
- 24 collect, averaging 100 each month; and
