1           WHEREAS, The family-owned engineering firm Dikita  
2 Enterprises of Dallas is celebrating the 30th anniversary of its  
3 founding in 2009; and

4           WHEREAS, Now one of the largest minority-owned engineering  
5 companies in Dallas, Dikita Enterprises was founded in Milwaukee,  
6 Wisconsin, in 1979 by Lucious L. Williams, who used his car as  
7 collateral to secure a start-up loan; and

8           WHEREAS, After several successful years in Milwaukee, Dikita  
9 opened its Dallas office in 1983, and it has since managed offices  
10 in Fort Worth, Beaumont, Port Arthur, and Shreveport, Louisiana; it  
11 currently operates a location in San Diego along with its corporate  
12 headquarters in Dallas; and

13           WHEREAS, The firm's name translates as "bringing the  
14 community together for its greater good," and over the past three  
15 decades, Dikita has built a strong reputation as a premier  
16 multidisciplinary engineering, planning, and management consulting  
17 firm, with clients in both the public and private sectors; and

18           WHEREAS, The company's two divisions, Dikita Engineering and  
19 Dikita Management Services, have overseen more than a billion  
20 dollars' worth of projects, including data collection for Dallas  
21 Area Rapid Transit, construction management for the Starplex  
22 Amphitheatre, engineering and design services for the South Oak  
23 Cliff Rail Line, and management of bond programs for a number of  
24 Texas school districts and universities; and

1           WHEREAS, Still owned and run by Mr. Williams as president and  
2 CEO, the company has further benefited from the active involvement  
3 of his daughter, Eve Williams, who serves as vice president and  
4 chief financial officer; Mr. Williams's granddaughter, Erika, has  
5 started to work for the company while she completes her engineering  
6 degree at Texas A&M University; and

7           WHEREAS, The prosperity of the Lone Star State depends in  
8 large part on the strength and innovative spirit of family-owned  
9 businesses, and the three generations of the Williams family are  
10 helping to ensure that Dikita Enterprises will continue to thrive  
11 well into the 21st century; now, therefore, be it
