

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, For the second consecutive year, CPS Energy has been
2 ranked number one in wind energy capacity among municipal utilities
3 by the American Wind Energy Association; and

4 WHEREAS, CPS Energy was further honored by AWEA as the
5 Municipal Utility of the Year for its continued growth and
6 leadership in renewable wind energy; and

7 WHEREAS, The nation's largest municipally owned energy
8 company, CPS Energy serves some 690,000 electric and nearly 320,000
9 natural gas customers in and around San Antonio; it currently
10 receives approximately 578 megawatts of wind power from three
11 sources, including the Cottonwood Creek, Desert Sky, and Penascal
12 Wind Farms; and

13 WHEREAS, CPS Energy is working to reach an ambitious goal of
14 having 20 percent of peak energy demand powered by renewable energy
15 by the year 2020; through its program Windtricity, customers can
16 opt to purchase wind power to help meet their energy needs; and

18 environment and conserve natural resources, CPS Energy has set an
19 outstanding example of public responsibility, and San Antonio
20 residents may indeed take pride in this visionary municipal
21 utility; now, therefore, be it
