

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The family and friends of U.S. Army Second
2 Lieutenant Peter H. Burks of Dallas sustained a heavy loss with the
3 death of this courageous soldier in Iraq on November 14, 2007, at
4 the age of 26; and

5 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Burks was killed by an improvised
6 explosive device in Baghdad while serving as a member of the 4th
7 Squadron, 2nd Stryker Cavalry Regiment, which is based in Vilseck,
8 Germany; and

9 WHEREAS, Born on April 10, 1981, in Atlanta, Georgia, Pete
10 Burks was the son of Jackie Merck and Alan Burks; he developed his
11 strong spiritual faith early in his life and graduated from Trinity
12 Christian Academy in 1999; and

13 WHEREAS, After beginning his college studies at the
14 University of Georgia, he transferred to Texas A&M University,
15 where he became a member of Pi Kappa Phi and served as a
16 sportswriter for the *Battalion*; he graduated with a bachelor's
17 degree in international studies and then held jobs as a tour guide
18 in Nice, France, and as an employee of the Dallas Cowboys, the
19 Dallas Desperados, and FC Dallas; in addition, he was very active in
20 the Young Life youth ministry organization; and

21 WHEREAS, This dedicated young man answered his nation's call
22 to duty in April 2006 and enlisted in the U.S. Army; he
23 distinguished himself in his training courses and developed into an
24 officer of great integrity and courage; given the role of a troop

1 leader in the 2nd Stryker Cavalry Regiment, he soon won the lasting
2 respect and admiration of his fellow soldiers; and

3 WHEREAS, Inspired by a love of country and a desire to serve a
4 higher calling, Pete Burks embodied the highest ideals of the armed
5 services, and those who shared in his love and friendship will
6 forever treasure their memories of him; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
8 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of U.S. Army Second
9 Lieutenant Peter H. Burks and extend deepest condolences to the
10 members of his family: to his mother, Jackie Merck; to his father,
11 Alan Burks; to his sisters, Ali, Sarah, and Georgia Burks; to his
12 brother, Zac Burks; to his fiancée, Melissa Haddad; to his
13 grandmother, Irene Merck; to his grandfather, Haskell Burks; to his
14 nephews, Oliver and Liam Denson; to his aunts and uncles, Brenda and
15 Jim Brooks, Laurie and Ivan Killen, Carlton and Bonnie Hays, Mike
16 and Susan Burks, and Tim Merck; and to his other relatives and many
17 friends; and, be it further

19 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of
20 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Second
21 Lieutenant Peter Burks.
