- 8 Germany; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Born on April 10, 1981, in Atlanta, Georgia, Pete
- 10 Burks was the son of Jackie Merck and Alan Burks; he developed his
- 11 strong spiritual faith early in his life and graduated from Trinity
- 12 Christian Academy in 1999; and
- 13 WHEREAS, After beginning his college studies at the
- 14 University of Georgia, he transferred to Texas A&M University,
- 15 where he became a member of Pi Kappa Phi and served as a
- 16 sportswriter for the Battalion; he graduated with a bachelor's
- 17 degree in international studies and then held jobs as a tour guide
- 18 in Nice, France, and as an employee of the Dallas Cowboys, the
- 19 Dallas Desperados, and FC Dallas; in addition, he was very active in
- 20 the Young Life youth ministry organization; and
- 21 WHEREAS, This dedicated young man answered his nation's call
- 22 to duty in April 2006 and enlisted in the U.S. Army; he
- 23 distinguished himself in his training courses and developed into an
- 24 officer of great integrity and courage; given the role of a troop

- 1 leader in the 2nd Stryker Cavalry Regiment, he soon won the lasting
- 2 respect and admiration of his fellow soldiers; and
