3 Missouri City, who died on June 6, 2007, at the age of 28; and

4 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 5th Squadron, 73rd Cavalry Regiment,
5 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 82nd Airborne Division, Staff Sergeant
6 Cole was killed while bravely serving his country in Iraq; and
