1 WHEREAS, The family and friends of U.S. Army Specialist James  
2 Lee Adair of Carthage suffered an immeasurable loss with the death  
3 of this valiant soldier in Iraq on June 29, 2007, at the age of 26;  
4 and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 1st Battalion, 28th Infantry  
6 Regiment, 4th Infantry Brigade Combat Team, 1st Infantry Division,  
7 based at Fort Riley, Kansas, Specialist Adair lost his life while  
8 bravely serving his country in Baghdad; and

9 WHEREAS, Lee Adair was born on November 16, 1980, in Cameron  
10 County and grew up in Carthage, where he was a member of American  
11 Legion Post No. 353; in 2006, he married the former Chelsea Nation,  
12 and at the time of his passing, he eagerly awaited the birth of his  
13 first child, Avery Lee; and

14 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's  
15 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous  
16 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect  
17 and gratitude; through his unwavering dedication to duty and honor,  
18 James Lee Adair embodied the highest ideals of the United States  
19 Army, and memories of his love and friendship will forever be  
20 cherished by all those who held him dear; now, therefore, be it
