2 U.S. Army Specialist Aaron James Walker of Harker Heights, who died
3 on September 18, 2007, at the age of 23; and

4 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 3rd Squadron, 2nd Stryker Cavalry
5 Regiment, 1st Armored Division, based out of Vilseck, Germany,
6 Specialist Walker lost his life during combat operations in
7 Baghdad, Iraq; and

8 WHEREAS, "A. J." Walker, the son of loving parents Darryl and
9 Annie Walker, grew up in Arkansas, attending high school in Little
10 Rock, where he was a member of the football team; also active in his
11 church, he played drums in its band and helped his dad with his
12 duties as youth pastor; and

13 WHEREAS, Known for his passion for life, Specialist Walker
14 loved his country and followed in his father's footsteps when he
15 joined the military; above all else, he was devoted to his family,
16 including his wife, Amber; and

17 WHEREAS, Our state and nation are fortunate to have men and
18 women whose love for their country inspires them to take up military
19 service, yet the tragic death of this fine soldier is a sobering
20 reminder of the cost of war; Specialist Walker embodied the highest
21 ideals of the U.S. armed forces, and those who knew and loved him
22 will forever carry him close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it
