## RESOLUTION

5 WHEREAS, Mayor Leppert has further distinguished himself 6 through his involvement in several community organizations, 7 including the Baylor Health Care System and the Dallas Committee on 8 Foreign Relations; a former chair of the Dallas Regional Chamber, 9 he continues to serve on the group's executive committee, and he is 10 the vice chair of the board of trustees for Claremont McKenna 11 College; and

WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Tom Leppert enjoys the love and support of his wife, Laura, and the couple have been blessed with three children, Christian, Catherine, and Ryan; and
