R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The family and friends of U.S. Army Sergeant Reuben  
2 Marcus Fernandez III of Abilene suffered an immeasurable loss with  
3 the death of this valiant soldier on October 11, 2008, at the age of  
4 22; and

5           WHEREAS, Assigned to the 2nd Squadron, 7th Cavalry Regiment,  
6 4th Brigade Combat Team, 1st Cavalry Division, based out of Fort  
7 Hood, Sergeant Fernandez lost his life while bravely serving his  
8 country on his second tour of duty in Iraq; and

9           WHEREAS, The son of Aurora Flores Fernandez and the late  
10 Reuben M. Fernandez, Jr., Marcus Fernandez graduated from Cooper  
11 High School in 2004 and joined the Army soon after; he planned to  
12 dedicate his life to the military and was highly decorated  
13 throughout his career, earning the Army Commendation Medal, Army  
14 Achievement Medal, Army Good Conduct Medal, National Defense  
15 Service Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, and Global War on Terrorism  
16 Service Medal; and

17           WHEREAS, Responsible, respectful, and strong-willed,  
18 Sergeant Fernandez also had a lighthearted side and he was known for  
19 his infectious laughter and expressive eyes; he always kept in  
20 close contact with his family and friends, and he won the affection  
21 of all who knew him; and

22           WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's  
23 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous  
24 sacrifices are deserving of the deepest respect and gratitude;

1 through his unwavering dedication to duty and honor, Marcus  
2 Fernandez embodied the highest ideals of the United States armed  
3 forces, and those who knew him will forever hold his memory close in  
4 their hearts; now, therefore, be it

5         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas  
6 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of U.S. Army Sergeant  
7 Reuben Marcus Fernandez III and extend sincere sympathy to his  
8 mother, Aurora Flores Fernandez, to his sister, Stephanie, and to  
9 all those who mourn his passing; and, be it further
