WHEREAS, In the coming years, the worldwide demand for wood and paper products is projected to increase, as is the need for biomass as a source of energy and transportation fuel; and

WHEREAS, The Texas Forestry Association recognizes that good stewardship programs, such as the Sustainable Forestry Initiative and the American Tree Farm System, must be maintained in order to establish new markets for wood and paper products and to provide a secure, productive future for the East Texas forest industry; and
