1 WHEREAS, The family and friends of U.S. Army Sergeant
2 Chadrick Omar Domino of Ennis suffered an immeasurable loss with
3 his death on May 31, 2007, at the age of 23; and

4 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry
5 Regiment, 3rd Brigade, 2nd Infantry Division (Stryker Brigade
6 Combat Team), out of Fort Lewis, Washington, this brave soldier
7 joined the army in 2002; he was serving his second tour of duty in
8 Iraq when he was killed in combat during a patrol in Baghdad; he was
9 promoted posthumously to sergeant; and

10 WHEREAS, Sergeant Domino's awards and decorations include
11 the Purple Heart, two Army Commendation Medals, a Meritorious Unit
12 Commendation, the National Defense Service Medal, the Global War on
13 Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service
14 Medal, the Army Service Ribbon, the Combat Infantryman Badge, and
15 the Combat Action Badge; and

16 WHEREAS, Chad Domino was born in Longview on June 21, 1983, to
17 Willis and Gloria Domino; he enjoyed comic books, music, dancing,
18 and good food; he also loved to play football and was a student of
19 karate; and

20 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
21 forces, Chadrick Domino inspired others with his courage and
22 fortitude, and although he is deeply missed, those who loved him
23 will forever carry his memory close in their hearts; now,
24 therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
2 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Sergeant Chadrick
3 Domino and extend sincere condolences to the members of his family:
4 to his father, Willis Domino; to his mother, Gloria Fullylove
5 Domino; to his sister, Ursula Domino; to his grandmother, Mary
6 Brown; to his stepgrandmother, Maggie Taylor; to his grandfather,
7 Alford Fullylove; and to his other relatives and friends; and, be it
