1 WHEREAS, Angleton Danbury Medical Center is celebrating 40

2 years of service to the citizens of Brazoria County in 2009; and

WHEREAS, Established by the legislature in 1967, Angleton

4 Danbury General Hospital opened in November 1969 with the purpose

5 of providing medical care to the residents of the Angleton and

6 Danbury area; the facility initially housed 34 licensed beds, but

7 five years later that number had increased to 54, after funds raised

8 by the community and matched by M. D. Anderson were used to complete

9 the hospital's east wing; and

10 WHEREAS, The demand for outpatient services increased

11 through the years, and \$9 million in bonds contributed to a

12 substantial expansion and renovation of the facility in 1989; a

13 decade later, construction of the \$7 million Surgical and Cardiac

14 Care Center was completed and the hospital became the Angleton

15 Danbury Medical Center; in 2002, the Frank W. Stevens Health and

16 Wellness Center was established, taking its name from a founding

17 board member who was a strong advocate of wellness programs long

18 before they were adopted by mainstream health care; and

19 WHEREAS, Striving to accommodate a growing population, the

20 medical center completed a \$22 million project in June 2006 that

21 impacted every patient care and service area on the campus; the

22 majority of the funding consisted of a \$20.3 million bond package, a

\$400,000 donation from the Peklo family, and a \$97,000 gift from the
