12 WHEREAS, This public-spirited citizen has provided outstanding news coverage of the Juneteenth celebrations on 13 14 Galveston Island for more than 17 years; as part of that effort, he has reported on the Ashton Villa Emancipation Prayer Vigil and 15 16 Breakfast and the Juneteenth Banquet at the historic Old Central Cultural Center for the past 12 years, and his work in keeping the 17 public informed has contributed to increased participation in the 18 19 observance; and

20 WHEREAS, Through his dedication, Harold Thomas has helped to 21 heighten awareness of the history of Juneteenth for visitors and 22 residents of Galveston alike; now, therefore, be it
