- 3 on April 28, 2008, at the age of 22; and

- 5 assigned to F Company, 94th Brigade Support Battalion, 4th Brigade
- 6 Combat Team, based at Fort Polk, Louisiana; he was mortally injured
- 7 while bravely serving his country in Baghdad, Iraq; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The son of Donald Stone and the late Bonnie Stone,
- 9 Mark Stone graduated from Kingsland Christian Academy; following in
- 10 his father's footsteps, he enlisted in the army and completed a
- 11 yearlong tour of duty in Afghanistan in 2006; he was deployed to
- 12 Iraq in November of the following year, and the heroism he
- 13 demonstrated in battle earned him numerous decorations, including
- 14 the Purple Heart and Bronze Star Medal; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Sergeant Stone was a quiet, thoughtful, and
- 16 determined young man who performed his military duties with
- 17 enthusiasm, exceeding standards and positively influencing his
- 18 fellow soldiers; he was greatly admired for his strength of
- 19 character and integrity, as well as for his kind, helpful nature;

- 21 WHEREAS, When he was on leave, Sergeant Stone attended all
- 22 three weekly services at Calvary Hill Church in Kingsland, where he
- 23 was a valued member; he helped take care of the children on church
- 24 field trips and expressed a desire to one day serve as a military
