

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Family and friends are mourning the loss of John
2 Ernest Phillips of Dallas, who passed away on March 20, 2009, at the
3 age of 69; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on a farm near Italy, Texas, on April 10, 1939,
5 John Phillips relocated to Levelland as a youth, and he went on to
6 graduate from Hardin-Simmons University and later Baylor Law
7 School; in addition, he earned a master's degree from the Dedman
8 School of Law at Southern Methodist University, and he completed
9 the Ranch Management Program at Texas Christian University;
10 answering his nation's call to duty, Mr. Phillips joined the United
11 States Army, and he was commissioned as a first lieutenant and
12 awarded the Army Commendation Medal; and

13 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan became a trial lawyer, working
14 on numerous cases and serving as the president of the Dallas
15 Association of Defense Lawyers; for a decade, he led the General
16 Litigation Division at Strasburger and Price, LLP, in Dallas, and
17 after 33 years with the firm, he retired as a senior partner in
18 2001; on his retirement, Mr. Phillips continued raising Aberdeen
19 Angus cattle in Italy; he was also active in his community of faith,
20 and he was a deacon at Central Baptist Church of Italy and at Park
21 Cities Baptist Church in Dallas, where he was a member of the Bob
22 and Ruth Glaze Sunday School class for more than 20 years; and

23 WHEREAS, John Phillips was a dedicated professional and a
24 caring citizen, and although he will be deeply missed, he will

1 forever be remembered with great admiration and affection by those
2 who were fortunate enough to know him; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
4 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of John Ernest
5 Phillips and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family:
6 to his wife of nearly 50 years, Barbara; to his son, John Edd, and
7 his wife, Lisa; to his daughter, Jan; to his grandson, Walter; to
8 his mother, Ernestine Phillips; to his brother, Joe Don Phillips,
9 and his sister, Tina Swenson; and to his other relatives and
10 friends; and, be it further
