- 12 community as a firefighter with the Venus Volunteer Fire
- 13 Department; he graduated in 2005 from Venus High School and

- 18 decorations, including the National Defense Service Medal, the Army

- 22 women whose love of country leads them to military duty, and time
- 23 can never diminish the profound debt that Americans owe to Thomas
- 24 Hilbert for the service he undertook and the sacrifice he rendered;
