5 WHEREAS, A cavalry scout assigned to the 1st Squadron, 9th 6 Cavalry Regiment, 4th Brigade Combat Team, 1st Cavalry Division, 7 stationed at Fort Bliss, Corporal Hilbert was mortally injured 8 during combat operations in Mosul, Iraq; a specialist at the time of 9 his death, he was posthumously promoted to corporal and awarded a 10 Purple Heart and a Bronze Star; and

11 WHEREAS, Born on January 14, 1987, Thomas Hilbert served his 12 community as a firefighter with the Venus Volunteer Fire 13 Department; he graduated in 2005 from Venus High School and 14 subsequently enlisted in the army; an enthusiastic and endearing 15 young man, he was devoted to his family, friends, and fellow 16 soldiers; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Hilbert was the recipient of several decorations, including the National Defense Service Medal, the Army Service Ribbon, the Good Conduct Medal, and the Iraq Campaign Medal; and

21 WHEREAS, Our state and nation are fortunate to have men and 22 women whose love of country leads them to military duty, and time 23 can never diminish the profound debt that Americans owe to Thomas 24 Hilbert for the service he undertook and the sacrifice he rendered;
