- 10 East Peach Street, now 13th Street, with handmade bricks salvaged
- 11 from the original Capitol, which had been destroyed by fire; since
- 12 then, the church has grown considerably and has moved twice because
- 13 of expansion of the Capitol grounds; the cornerstones of the first
- 14 two churches have been placed in the front wall of the present
- 15 building, which was dedicated in 1960 and is located on West 15th
- 16 Street; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Over the past 125 years, the church has ministered
- 18 faithfully to the needs of the citizens of Austin and has continued
- 19 to grow and prosper; the church has a Lutheran school and a
- 20 Stephen's Ministry and offers a variety of support groups and
- 21 outreach programs; and
- 22 WHEREAS, The church has also served as an invaluable source
- 23 of strength to its members during their hardships and in difficult
