WHEREAS, Born on August 20, 1916, in Paris, Texas, the former Margaret L. Rowland was the daughter of Lanis and Margaret E. Rowland; she married L. T. Felty on April 17, 1936, and together the couple shared nearly six decades and raised three children before his death in 1996; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Felty graduated from Texas Christian 10 University with a bachelor's degree in elementary education and 11 went on to earn a master's degree in history from The University of 12 Texas at Arlington; she was an enthusiastic and attentive first grade teacher at Northside Elementary School in Waxahachie for many 13 14 years, and she was recognized with the 2006 Outstanding Elementary Educator's award by the Waxahachie Ex-Students Association; 15 moreover, in September 2008, the Waxahachie Independent School 16 District paid tribute to Mrs. Felty by dedicating the Margaret L. 17 Felty Elementary School in her honor; and 18

WHEREAS, Following her retirement, 19 Mrs. Felty gave generously of her time and energy in behalf of numerous 20 21 organizations, including the Ellis County Retired School Personnel, the Daughters of the American Revolution, the Ellis 22 23 County Genealogical Society, and the Ellis County Historical Commission, which she served as chair for 14 years; in addition, she 24
