4 WHEREAS, Born on October 10, 1910, to Jim and Minnie Lisman,
5 the former Lois Lisman attended Garrett High School and served with
6 the U.S. Postal Service as assistant postmaster in Palmer; and

7 WHEREAS, Mrs. Erisman knew the sadness of losing three
8 husbands, but each of her marriages brought new loved ones into her
9 life; she was first married to Harris Hughey, and she later wed Dick
10 Wynne and, finally, Dr. Robert Erisman; Mrs. Erisman had three
11 children of her own, Ray and Wallace Hughey and Sue Peace, who
12 preceded her mother in death; in addition, Mr. Wynne's daughter,
13 Rosemary, became part of the family, as did the children of Dr.

15 any of the children as a "stepchild" and loved each of them with all
