5 in Montebello, California, the former Carol Brewer graduated from  
6 Pacific Christian College in 1965; she married Raymond Clymore the  
7 following year and dedicated her energies to raising her family and  
8 serving her church, where she sang in the choir, led women's groups,  
9 and taught Sunday school; the couple were blessed with three  
10 daughters, Laura, Leslie, and Lindsay, and with the passing years,  
11 their family grew to include six grandchildren; and

12           WHEREAS, Mrs. Clymore and her family moved to Waxahachie in  
13 the 1980s, and she immediately became active at the First Baptist  
14 Church; she was president of the Baptist Women, taught Sunday  
15 school and Bible study, and was involved with the choir; later, she  
16 attended Waxahachie Bible Church and contributed to the  
17 congregation in numerous ways, including by greeting congregants at  
18 the chapel door; Mrs. Clymore also gave back to the community by  
19 working as a major organizer of Waxahachie Mobile Meals; and

20           WHEREAS, Carol Clymore lived a caring and purposeful life,  
21 and her legacy of providing compassionate service to others will  
22 continue to inspire her loved ones and all those who had the good  
23 fortune to know her; now, therefore, be it
