- 5 WHEREAS, On September 16, 1810, Father Hidalgo led several
- 6 hundred people in taking the prison in Dolores, Mexico, thus
- 7 launching the events that culminated in Mexican independence in
- 8 1821; the passionate speech the priest delivered on that day, the
- 9 Grito de Dolores, declaring "death to bad government," has since
- 10 become known as the "cry for Mexican independence"; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The year 2010 also marks the 158th anniversary of
- 12 the creation of Hidalgo County and the convening, on September 2,
- 13 1852, of its first county court; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The 200th anniversary of the beginning of the
- 15 Mexican War for Independence represents a fitting opportunity to
- 16 celebrate the heroism and patriotism of Father Hidalgo, as well as
- 17 the inextricable links between the histories of Mexico and Texas;
- 18 now, therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
- 20 Legislature hereby recognize the bicentennial in 2010 of the Grito
- 21 de Dolores and celebrate the continuing inspiration of Father
- 22 Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla.
