WHEREAS, "Wesley" Burkett was born in Brownwood on January 9 27, 1984; he attended Zephyr High School, where he participated in 10 11 UIL academic competition, and went on to Ranger Junior College; he 12 married the former Brandi Peel on December 18, 2005, and joined the army in April 2006 as an armor crewman; this devoted family man 13 14 bought a house in Killeen for his wife and their son and spent as much time as possible with them before his deployment to Iraq in 15 16 November 2007; and

for 17 WHEREAS, Known his positive attitude, quiet intelligence, and endearing smile, Specialist Burkett was deeply 18 committed to providing a good life for his family, and was looking 19 20 forward to furthering his education in order to advance in his 21 military career; he was a member of the VFW Killeen Chapter and received a number of decorations, including the National Defense 22 23 Service Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Medal, the Army Service Medal, the Bronze Star, and the Purple Heart; and 24
