16 encouraged and supported them in all their endeavors; and

18 in the outdoors; an avid hunter and fisherman, he was also an ardent  
19 computer technology enthusiast; and

20           WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan held membership in the Fort  
21 Worth Professional Firefighters Association, Local No. 440, and the  
22 International Association of Fire Fighters; in addition, he was a  
23 valued congregant of the Azle Church of Christ; and
