R E S O L U T I O N

2 Houston, Dr. Edith Clark has built an impressive record of service  
3 that has been of great benefit to her fellow citizens; and

4           WHEREAS, Born in Waller County, Dr. Clark attended Tulane  
5 University in New Orleans and earned advanced degrees in  
6 cosmetology; she was the owner and operator of Clark's House of  
7 Glamour until her retirement and is a former president of the  
8 Sunnyside Beauticians Club; moreover, she has served in several  
9 leadership positions with Theta Nu Sigma National Sorority; and

10           WHEREAS, Dr. Clark's civic leadership has taken many forms;  
11 she organized the first Juneteenth celebration at Mt. Vernon  
12 Baptist Church in 1978, and she was instrumental in the  
13 reorganization of the Sunnyside Civic Club; in addition, she served  
14 as the first honorary mayor of Sunnyside, was a member of the board  
15 for the Metropolitan Transit Authority, and has been a very active  
16 congregant of Evangelist Chapel African Methodist Episcopal  
17 Church, where she has held various administrative offices; and

18           WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan has received numerous honors for  
19 her professional and community service work throughout her life,  
20 including the Outstanding Cosmetology Award, the Excellence Award  
21 from Greater True Light Church of God in Christ, the Unsung Heroes  
22 Award from State Representative Alma Allen, and the Pillar of  
23 Community Award from Sunnyside Place Community Development  
24 Corporation; and

1           WHEREAS, Edith Clark has devoted herself to strengthening her  
2 community, and she may take justifiable pride in the many positive  
3 changes that have resulted from her work; now, therefore, be it
