19 department; in addition, she has instituted SAT and PSAT
20 preparatory courses and mentored new teachers at the school, and
21 she is planning to serve on the Aledo ISD Strategic Planning
22 Committee; Ms. Hill has further contributed to such organizations
23 as the United Educators Association of Texas and the National
24 Council of Teachers of English; and

3 pride in their daughter, Christi Hill-Kothmann; Ms. Hill also
