RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Real Estate Councils of Texas was formed in 2008 2 to serve as an industry resource and to enhance the role of real 3 estate within the state's economy; and

WHEREAS, Recognizing a need for statewide representation, 4 5 real estate professionals from across Texas have formed a coalition to educate the public on issues that affect the industry 6 7 and to advocate in behalf of the industry; the founding members are the Real Estate Councils of San Antonio, Austin, and Dallas, as well 8 9 as the Greater Fort Worth Real Estate Council, the Houston Real Estate Council, and Houstonians for Responsible Growth; the Real 10 11 Estate Councils of Texas represents the state's major markets, and its mission is to serve as the unified voice of the real estate 12 development industry of Texas and to establish a statewide economic 13 14 footprint; and

WHEREAS, By working together, the members of the Real Estate Councils of Texas hope to ensure that the public becomes aware of the significant impact the industry has on the state's economy; in 2007, the real estate industry provided approximately \$3.8 billion in state tax revenue and generated more than \$270 billion in total economic activity; moreover, it contributed \$76.8 billion in labor income and produced 1.75 million total jobs; and
