

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Valley Building Officials Association in South
2 Texas is celebrating the 50th anniversary of its founding in 2009;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, During the 1950s, communities in the Lower Rio
5 Grande Valley were adopting housing and building codes in order to
6 qualify for state and federal funds; some community members,
7 however, began to question the effectiveness of local code
8 enforcement; and

9 WHEREAS, In 1959, in response to these concerns, building
10 officials for the City of Edinburg took the lead in establishing an
11 organization called the Building Trades Inspectors Association of
12 the Lower Rio Grande Valley; the group changed its name to the
13 Valley Building Officials Association in 1964; and

14 WHEREAS, Thanks to the hard work and determination of
15 dedicated building inspectors over the past half-century, the VBOA
16 has continued to serve the citizens of the Valley by expanding the
17 knowledge and unifying the procedures of building officials
18 throughout the area; since the establishment of this pioneering
19 association, similar groups have been created across the region and
20 the state; and

21 WHEREAS, These outstanding municipal and industry
22 professionals have contributed greatly to the quality of life in
23 the Lower Rio Grande Valley, and they may take great pride in their
24 proud history; now, therefore, be it
