18 expansion of the Henderson County Jail; he was also a past president

19 of the Cedar Creek Lake Area Chamber of Commerce and a recipient of

20 the group's Lifetime Achievement Award, and he was the chair of the

21 Henderson County Republican Party from 1999 to 2007; moreover, he

22 was a member of the Scottish Rite and the Order of the Eastern Star

23 and a 32nd degree Mason; and
