R E S O L U T I O N

2 people of Aransas County as county judge since 2007, and his
3 knowledge of local issues and dedication to the public good have

6 country with distinction in Vietnam as a member of the U.S. Air

10 children, Lieutenant Colonel Jason Mills and his wife, Julianne,

13 WHEREAS, Judge Mills first entered politics in 1978, when he
14 was elected to the Rockport City Council; he went on to serve four
15 terms as mayor, and his outstanding leadership contributed to a
16 number of worthwhile improvements, including the development of
17 Rockport Beach Park; and

18 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan currently serves as a member of
19 the Governor's Commission on Disaster Recovery and Preparedness and
20 as treasurer of the Coastal Bend Council of Governments; in
21 addition, he is a member of the Rockport-Fulton Chamber of
22 Commerce, a lifetime member of the Stewart/Wendell VFW Post, and a
23 valued congregant of the First Presbyterian Church; and
