1           WHEREAS, A member of Epsilon Sigma Alpha International for 50  
2 years, Audrey Eoff of Weslaco is being honored for her myriad  
3 contributions to this outstanding organization at its

6           WHEREAS, Founded in 1929, ESA is an international leadership  
7 and service organization with some 12,000 members in more than  
8 1,000 chapters; Mrs. Eoff belongs to Lambda Iota Chapter No. 2665  
9 and has achieved her 5th Degree of Pallas Athene; currently serving  
10 for the fourth time as ESA District III president, she also recently  
11 served as Texas awards chair for ESA; she herself has won numerous  
12 awards through the years, including the top prize in international  
13 ESA competition as editor of the 2007-2008 state news magazine, *The*  
14 *TESAN*, and she was selected as Outstanding ESA Member for the State  
15 of Texas in 2005-2006; moreover, she was recognized at the  
16 organization's state convention in May 2009 with a 50-year service  
17 pin; and

18           WHEREAS, Among the many organizations that benefit from the  
19 efforts of ESA members are St. Jude Children's Research Hospital  
20 and the American Cancer Society; since 1972, Mrs. Eoff has worked  
21 diligently in behalf of ESA's successful national fund-raising

23 the hospital's founder, entertainer Danny Thomas, at the IC

3 Unit Board of the American Cancer Society for more than two decades  
4 and is currently serving as president; a cancer survivor, she has  
5 given generously of her time and talents to the Mid Valley Relay for

7 aiding individuals with cancer; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Eoff retired from the teaching profession after  
9 25 years, and she continues to lead education workshops and work as  
10 a consultant; she has been a valued member of St. Pius X Catholic  
11 Church for more than five decades and has served as chair of the  
12 Disciples in Mission Program and on a number of commissions; a  
13 devoted wife and mother, she is supported in all her endeavors by  
14 the love of her husband, Therman Eoff, and their 6 children and 13  
15 grandchildren; and

16 WHEREAS, Through a half-century of dedicated service to  
17 Epsilon Sigma Alpha, Audrey Eoff has set an inspiring example of  
18 leadership and commitment, and her many accomplishments indeed  
19 merit special recognition; now, therefore, be it
