- BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
- 2 Texas, 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, That House Rule 13,
- 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
- 4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
- 5 resolve the differences on House Bill 3612, relating to the
- 6 creation of a pilot program that allows taxpayer appeals from
- 7 certain appraisal review board determinations in certain counties
- 8 to be heard by the State Office of Administrative Hearings, to
- 9 consider and take action on the following matter:
- House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(1) and (2), are suspended to
- 11 permit the committee to change and omit text which is not in
- 12 disagreement in SECTION 1 of the bill, in added Section 2003.902,
- 13 Government Code, by deleting Dallas County, which was included in
- 14 both the house and senate versions of the bill, from the counties in
- 15 which the pilot program created by the bill is to be implemented, so
- 16 that the section reads as follows:
- 17 Sec. 2003.902. COUNTIES INCLUDED. The pilot program shall
- 18 be implemented in Bexar, Cameron, El Paso, Harris, Tarrant, and
- 19 Travis Counties for a three-year period beginning with the ad
- 20 valorem tax year that begins January 1, 2010.
- 21 Explanation: This change is necessary to remove Dallas
- 22 County from the counties in which the pilot program created by H.B.
- 23 No. 3612 is to be implemented.
