1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of

Texas, 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, That House Rule 13,

3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,

4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to

5 resolve the differences on House Bill 1796 (the development of

6 carbon dioxide capture and sequestration in this state) to consider

7 and take action on the following matter:

8 House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(3) and (4), are suspended to

permit the committee to add text on a matter not in disagreement and

10 not included in either the house or senate version of the bill by

11 adding the following SECTION to the bill:

12 SECTION 30. The purpose of the changes in law made by this

13 Act is to encourage the development of onshore and offshore

14 geologic storage of carbon dioxide including by encouraging the

15 development of advanced clean energy projects that capture carbon

16 dioxide and sequester not less than 50 percent of the captured

17 carbon dioxide in onshore or offshore geologic repositories.

18 Securing the necessary capacity for geologic sequestration is

essential to the success of carbon capture strategies, such as the

20 advanced clean energy projects facilitated by the changes in law

21 made by this Act. The success of the offshore repositories

22 facilitated by this Act depends on an adequate supply of

23 anthropogenic carbon dioxide, which is not currently being captured

24 at industrial facilities in this state. The advanced clean energy
