R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Neerman family of Lake Highlands are among the
2 many North Texas residents who have benefited from the
3 comprehensive, high-quality services offered at the Neonatal
4 Intensive Care Unit of Baylor University Medical Center at Dallas;

8 early and weighed only 1 pound, 11 ounces; in this critical
