1 WHEREAS, Family and friends suffered an immeasurable loss
2 with the death of Myles Julian Anderson of El Paso on November 9,
3 2006, at the age of 20; and

4 WHEREAS, Myles Anderson was born in El Paso on August 31,
5 1986, to Chris and Kayla Anderson; he attended Cathedral High
6 School, where he showed true promise as an actor, accumulating more
7 credits as a performer than anyone else in the school's history; and

8 WHEREAS, For a government class project, Mr. Anderson
9 prepared a tribute in memory of a classmate who died while serving
10 his country in Iraq; the resolution became H.R. 161, which was
11 adopted during the 79th Texas Legislative Session; Mr. Anderson
12 accompanied his mentor, Chief Justice Richard Barajas, to the State
13 Capitol, and was present when the measure was read on the house
14 floor; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Anderson went on to attend St. Edwards
16 University in Austin, where he discovered a new passion,
17 photography; he returned to El Paso to pursue this interest, and his
18 work was exhibited in several local galleries; and

19 WHEREAS, Myles Anderson is remembered by all who knew him as a
20 warm and outgoing young man who befriended young and old alike; he
21 was known for offering to cut the grass of elderly members of his
22 church and to take nothing more than a glass of tea and some good
23 conversation in return; and

24 WHEREAS, Although his life ended far too soon, memories of

1 this beloved young Texan will forever endure in the hearts of the
2 many people who held him dear; now, therefore, be it
