## RESOLUTION

- BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
- 2 Texas, 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, That House Rule 13,
- 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
- 4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
- 5 resolve the differences on House Bill 1959 (the governmental
- 6 entities subject to the sunset review process) to consider and take
- 7 action on the following matters:
- 8 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit
- 9 the committee to add the following:
- 10 SECTION 1.09. TEXAS STATE AFFORDABLE HOUSING CORPORATION.
- 11 (a) Section 2306.5521, Government Code, is amended to read as
- 12 follows:
- Sec. 2306.5521. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas State
- 14 Affordable Housing Corporation is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas
- 15 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that
- 16 chapter, the corporation is abolished and this subchapter expires
- 17 September 1, 2011 [<del>2009</del>].
- 18 (b) This section takes effect only if the 81st Legislature,
- 19 Regular Session, 2009, does not enact other legislation that
- 20 becomes law and that amends Section 2306.5521, Government Code, to
- 21 extend the sunset date of the Texas State Affordable Housing
- 22 Corporation. If the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009,
- 23 enacts legislation of that kind, this section has no effect.
- 24 SECTION 1.10. TEXAS RACING COMMISSION. (a) Subsection

- 1 (a), Section 18.01, Texas Racing Act (Article 179e, Vernon's Texas
- 2 Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) The Texas Racing Commission is subject to Chapter 325,
- 4 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence
- 5 as provided by that chapter, and except as provided by Subsections
- 6 (b) and (c) of this section, the commission is abolished and this
- 7 Act expires September 1, 2011 [2009].
- 8 (b) This section takes effect only if the 81st Legislature,
- 9 Regular Session, 2009, does not enact other legislation that
- 10 becomes law and that amends Section 18.01, Texas Racing Act
- 11 (Article 179e, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), to extend the sunset
- 12 date of the Texas Racing Commission. If the 81st Legislature,
- 13 Regular Session, 2009, enacts legislation of that kind, this
- 14 section has no effect.
- 15 SECTION 1.11. TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE. (a) Section
- 16 31.004(a), Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) The Texas Department of Insurance is subject to Chapter
- 18 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in
- 19 existence as provided by that chapter, the department is abolished
- 20 September 1, 2011 [2009].
- 21 (b) This section takes effect only if the 81st Legislature,
- 22 Regular Session, 2009, does not enact other legislation that
- 23 becomes law and that amends Section 31.004(a), Insurance Code, to
- 24 extend the sunset date of the Texas Department of Insurance. If the
- 25 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, enacts legislation of that
- 26 kind, this section has no effect.
- SECTION 1.12. TEXAS YOUTH COMMISSION. (a) Section 61.020,

- 1 Human Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 61.020. SUNSET PROVISION. (a) The Texas Youth
- 3 Commission is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset
- 4 Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter,
- 5 the commission is abolished and this chapter expires September 1,
- 6 2011 [<del>2009</del>].
- 7 (b) In the review of the Texas Youth Commission by the
- 8 Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this section, the sunset
- 9 commission shall focus its review on:
- 10 (1) the commission's compliance with Chapter 263 (S.B.
- 11 103), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007;
- 12 (2) requirements placed on the agency by legislation
- 13 enacted by the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, that
- 14 becomes law, including implementation of programs for the diversion
- 15 of youth from the commission; and
- 16 (3) initiatives of the commission and the Texas
- 17 Juvenile Probation Commission in coordinating activities and
- 18 services to better integrate Texas Youth Commission, Texas Juvenile
- 19 Probation Commission, and county juvenile justice functions,
- 20 including joint strategic planning, the sharing of youth data
- 21 across youth-serving agencies, assessments and classification of
- 22 youth, and collection of data on probation outcomes.
- 23 <u>(c) In its report to the 82nd Legislature, the sunset</u>
- 24 commission may include any recommendations it considers
- 25 appropriate. This subsection and Subsection (b) expire September
- 26 1, 2011.
- 27 (b) This section takes effect only if the 81st Legislature,

- 1 Regular Session, 2009, does not enact other legislation that
- 2 becomes law and that amends Section 61.020, Human Resources Code,
- 3 to extend the sunset date of the Texas Youth Commission. If the
- 4 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, enacts legislation of that
- 5 kind, this section has no effect.
- 6 SECTION 1.13. TEXAS JUVENILE PROBATION COMMISSION. (a)
- 7 Section 141.012, Human Resources Code, is amended to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 Sec. 141.012. SUNSET PROVISION. (a) The Texas Juvenile
- 10 Probation Commission is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code
- 11 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by
- 12 that chapter, the commission is abolished and this chapter expires
- 13 September 1, 2011 [<del>2009</del>].
- 14 (b) In the review of the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission
- 15 by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this section, the
- 16 <u>sunset commission shall focus its review on the following:</u>
- 17 (1) the commission's compliance with Chapter 263 (S.B.
- 18 103), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007;
- 19 (2) requirements placed on the agency by legislation
- 20 enacted by the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, that
- 21 becomes law, including implementation of programs for the diversion
- 22 of youth from the Texas Youth Commission; and
- 23 (3) initiatives of the commission and the Texas Youth
- 24 Commission in coordinating activities and services to better
- 25 <u>integrate Texas Juvenile Probation Commission, Texas Youth</u>

- 10 to extend the sunset date of the Texas Juvenile Probation
- 11 Commission. If the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, enacts
- 12 legislation of that kind, this section has no effect.
- 13 SECTION 1.14. OFFICE OF INDEPENDENT OMBUDSMAN FOR THE TEXAS
- 14 YOUTH COMMISSION. (a) Section 64.054, Human Resources Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 64.054. SUNSET PROVISION. (a) The office is
- 17 subject to review under Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset
- 18 Act), but is not abolished under that chapter. The office shall be
- 19 reviewed during the periods in which the Texas Youth Commission is
- 20 [state agencies abolished in 2009 and every 12th year after 2009
- 21 are reviewed.
- (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the Sunset Advisory
- 23 <u>Commission shall focus its review of the office on compliance with</u>
- 24 requirements placed on the office by legislation enacted by the
- 25 <u>81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, that becomes law.</u> This
- 26 subsection expires September 1, 2011.
- (b) This section takes effect only if the 81st Legislature,

- 1 Regular Session, 2009, does not enact other legislation that
- 2 becomes law and that amends Section 64.054, Human Resources Code,
- 3 to extend the sunset date of the Office of Independent Ombudsman for
- 4 the Texas Youth Commission. If the 81st Legislature, Regular
- 5 Session, 2009, enacts legislation of that kind, this section has no
- 6 effect.
- 7 SECTION 1.15. OFFICE OF PUBLIC INSURANCE COUNSEL. Section
- 8 501.003, Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 501.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The office is subject to
- 10 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued
- 11 in existence as provided by that chapter, the office is abolished
- 12 September 1, 2011 [<del>2009</del>].
- 13 SECTION 1.16. TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY. (a)
- 14 Section 411.002, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection
- 15 (c) to read as follows:
- 16 (c) The Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas is
- 17 subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in
- 18 existence as provided by that chapter, the department is abolished
- 19 and Subsections (a) and (b) expire September 1, 2011 [2009].
- 20 (b) This section takes effect only if the 81st Legislature,
- 21 Regular Session, 2009, does not enact other legislation that
- 22 becomes law and that amends Section 411.002, Government Code, to
- 23 extend the sunset date of the Texas Department of Public Safety. If
- 24 the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, enacts legislation of
- 25 that kind, this section has no effect.
- 26 Explanation: The changes are necessary to change the sunset
- 27 review date for various state agencies.

- 1 (2) House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(1) and (2), are suspended
- 2 to permit the committee, in SECTION 1.17 of the bill, to change text
- 3 that is not in disagreement and to omit text that is not in
- 4 disagreement by amending Section 7.004, Education Code, to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 SECTION 1.17. TEXAS EDUCATION AGENCY. Section 7.004,
- 7 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 7.004. SUNSET PROVISION. (a) The Texas Education
- 9 Agency is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset
- 10 Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter,
- 11 the agency is abolished September 1,  $\underline{2011}$  [ $\underline{2012}$ ]. [ $\underline{In \ the \ review \ of}$
- 12 the agency by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this
- 13 section, the sunset commission shall limit its review to the
- 14 appropriateness of recommendations made by the sunset commission to
- 15 the 79th Legislature. In the Sunset Advisory Commission's report
- 16 to the 80th Legislature, the sunset commission may include any
- 17 recommendations it considers appropriate.
- 18 Explanation: The change is necessary to provide for the
- 19 sunset review of the Texas Education Agency in preparation for the
- 20 82nd Legislature.
- 21 (3) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit
- 22 the committee to add the following:
- 23 SECTION 2.12. OFFICE OF FIREFIGHTERS' PENSION
- 24 COMMISSIONER. Article 6243e, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes,
- 25 Section 21(h), is amended to read as follows:
- 26 (h) The office of fire fighters' pension commissioner is
- 27 subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless

- 1 continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the office is
- 2 abolished September 1, 2013  $\left[\frac{2011}{2}\right]$ .
- 3 SECTION 2.13. TEXAS LOTTERY COMMISSION. Section 467.002,
- 4 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 467.002. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The commission is
- 6 subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in
- 7 existence as provided by that chapter, the commission is abolished
- 8 and this chapter, Chapter 466 of this code, and Chapter 2001,
- 9 Occupations Code, expire September 1, 2013 [2011].
- 10 SECTION 2.14. TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. (a)
- 11 Section 201.204, Transportation Code, is amended to read as
- 12 follows:
- Sec. 201.204. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Department of
- 14 Transportation is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas
- 15 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that
- 16 chapter, the department is abolished September 1, 2013 [2009].
- 17 (b) This section takes effect only if the 81st Legislature,
- 18 Regular Session, 2009, does not enact other legislation that
- 19 becomes law and that amends Section 201.204, Transportation Code,
- 20 to extend the sunset date of the Texas Department of
- 21 Transportation. If the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009,
- 22 enacts legislation of that kind, this section has no effect.
- 23 SECTION 2.15. TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE, DIVISION OF
- 24 WORKERS' COMPENSATION. Section 31.004(b), Insurance Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (b) Unless continued as provided by Chapter 325, Government
- 27 Code, the duties of the division of workers' compensation of the

- 1 Texas Department of Insurance under Title 5, Labor Code, expire
- 2 September 1, 2013 [2011], or another date designated by the
- 3 legislature.
- 4 SECTION 2.16. OFFICE OF INJURED EMPLOYEE COUNSEL. Section
- 5 404.003, Labor Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 404.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The office of injured
- 7 employee counsel is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas
- 8 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that
- 9 chapter, the office is abolished and this chapter expires September
- 10 1, <u>2013</u> [<del>2011</del>].
- 11 Explanation: The changes are necessary to change the sunset
- 12 review date for various state agencies.
