RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Individuals of all ages are afflicted by rare, 2 chronic, and life-threatening genetic conditions, and they rely 3 upon vital plasma protein therapies; and

WHEREAS, Such disorders include hemophilia, Kawasaki disease, hepatitis, pediatric HIV, von Willebrand disease, and other immune system deficiencies, all of which are treated most effectively with the therapies produced from plasma and with the use of recombinant technology; and

9 WHEREAS, Patients who have access to the full range of plasma 10 protein therapies, to the appropriate providers, and to various 11 options in pharmacy and home-supported services often experience 12 the best possible clinical outcomes, and thus, a comprehensive 13 system of care is essential; and

14 WHEREAS, Plasma protein therapies help to ensure a higher 15 quality of life for many patients across the United States, and 16 greater awareness and understanding of this issue contributes to 17 the health and well-being of our communities; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas 19 Legislature hereby recognize August 2009 as Plasma Protein 20 Therapies Month in the Lone Star State and encourage all Texans to 21 learn more about the conditions that are treated by plasma protein 22 therapies and to explore the resources that are available to them.
