1 WHEREAS, Hal Talton has demonstrated an unwavering
2 commitment to his fellow Texans through his exceptional work as
3 chief of staff and general counsel for State Representative Dan
4 Gattis for more than six years; and

5 WHEREAS, During the 78th, 79th, 80th, and 81st Legislatures,
6 as well as all the days in between, Mr. Talton has provided vital
7 leadership and assistance in handling myriad tasks; his
8 professionalism has assured the efficient operation of the office,
9 allowing Representative Gattis to effectively devote his attention
