R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Bill Moore has served with great distinction as
2 president of the Texas Pharmacy Association for 2008-2009; and

3 WHEREAS, Founded in 1879, the TPA represents almost 4,000
4 members and works to unite and advance the pharmacy profession in
5 order to help Texans lead healthy lives; Mr. Moore has been a member
6 since 1963 and has served as chair of the TPA Insurance Trust, in
7 addition to holding numerous other leadership positions; a tireless
8 advocate for the association, he has long traveled the state to
9 visit pharmacy students, help develop local association chapters,
10 and recruit new members from the ranks of practicing pharmacists;
11 he is also a longtime member of the National Community Pharmacists
12 Association and the American Pharmacists Association; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Moore was born in Hallettsville and graduated
14 from The University of Texas College of Pharmacy in 1960; he worked
15 as a pharmacist in Ganado and Victoria before purchasing a pharmacy
16 in Sinton in 1965; today, Moore's Pharmacy, Inc., is an
17 independently owned group of three pharmacies in Sinton, Beeville,
18 and Corpus Christi that specialize in custom compounding; Mr.
19 Moore's son and fellow TPA member Robert Moore manages the Beeville
20 location; and

21 WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Moore shares a rewarding
22 marriage with his wife, Linda, and they take pleasure in spending
23 time with their 5 children, 11 grandchildren, and 2
24 great-grandchildren; he plays an active role in his church, and in

1 his free time he joins with his wife in devoting significant effort
2 to the fight against cancer; and

3 WHEREAS, After nearly half a century as a pharmacist, Bill
4 Moore continues to be a dynamic leader in his profession, with a
5 deep commitment to improving the health of his fellow Texans, and he
6 can indeed take pride in his outstanding tenure as president of the
