## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Texas is the only state in the nation whose name
- 2 officially refers to friends or friendship, as its name derives
- 3 from the Caddo Indian word for friends; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In February 1930, the Texas Legislature
- 5 demonstrated great wisdom when it voted to officially designate our
- 6 state motto as "Friendship"; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The phenomenal friendliness and accompanying
- 8 extroversion of Texans are a most impressive cultural strength of
- 9 our state, calling to mind the words of President Lyndon B. Johnson
- 10 of Texas, who famously said "that there are no enemies in this
- 11 world, only potential friends"; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The cities of Eagle Pass, Dallas, and Burkburnett
- 13 each host annual friendship festivals and, for the first time,
- 14 Houston hosted a friendship festival in 2009 that is expected to
- 15 become an annual event; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Currently, there is no major statewide
- 17 friendship-themed annual civic event open to the general public; a
- 18 day devoted to friendship would promote a healthy dialogue about
- 19 personal friendships and enrich the lives of all participants; now,
- 20 therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
- 22 Legislature hereby recognize August 2, 2009, as Texas Friendship
- 23 Day and encourage all Texans to reflect on the meaning of
- 24 friendships in their own lives.
