- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 142.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subdivision (3) and adding Subdivision (3-a) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (3) "Eligible institution" means an institution of
- 9 higher education[, as defined by Section 61.003(8) of this code].
- 10 (3-a) "Institution of higher education" and "medical
- 11 and dental unit" have the meanings assigned by Section 61.003.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 142.002, Education Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 142.002. PURPOSE. The advanced research program is
- 15 established to encourage and provide support for basic research
- 16 conducted by faculty members <u>and students</u> in astronomy, atmospheric
- 17 science, biological and behavioral sciences, chemistry, computer
- 18 sciences, earth sciences, engineering, information science,
- 19 mathematics, material sciences, oceanography, physics,
- 20 environmental issues affecting the Texas-Mexico border region, the
- 21 reduction of industrial, agricultural, and domestic water use,
- 22 social sciences, and related disciplines in eligible institutions.
- SECTION 3. Subsection (c), Section 142.003, Education Code,
- 24 is amended to read as follows:

C.S.S.B. No. 44

- 1 (c) The guidelines and procedures developed by the
- 2 coordinating board must:
- 3 <u>(1)</u> provide for awards on a competitive, peer review
- 4 basis for specific projects at eligible institutions; and
- 5 (2) require that, as a condition of receiving an
- 6 award, an eligible institution must use a portion of the award to
- 7 support, in connection with the project for which the award is made,
- 8 basic research conducted by:
- 9 (A) graduate or undergraduate students, if the
- 10 eligible institution is a medical and dental unit; or
- 11 (B) undergraduate students, if the eligible
- 12 institution is any other institution of higher education.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
