1-10 relating to the administration of the Juvenile Justice Case
1-11 Management System.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 58.403, Family Code, is amended to read
1-14 as follows:

1-15 Sec. 58.403. JUVENILE INFORMATION SYSTEM. (a) Through the
1-16 adoption of an interlocal contract under Chapter 791, Government
1-17 Code, with one or more counties, the ~~[The]~~ commission ~~[in
1-18 partnership with local counties]~~ may participate in and assist
1-19 counties in the creation, operation, and maintenance of a
1-20 ~~[statewide]~~ system that is intended for statewide use to:

1-21 (1) aid in processing the cases of children under this
1-22 title;

1-23 (2) facilitate the delivery of services to children in
1-24 the juvenile justice system;

1-25 (3) aid in the early identification of at-risk and
1-26 delinquent children; and

1-27 (4) facilitate cross-jurisdictional sharing of
1-28 information related to juvenile offenders between authorized
1-29 criminal and juvenile justice agencies and partner agencies.

1-30 (b) The commission may use funds appropriated for the
1-31 implementation of this section to pay costs incurred under an
1-32 interlocal contract described by Subsection (a), including license
1-33 fees, maintenance and operations costs, administrative costs, and
1-34 any other costs specified in the interlocal contract.

1-35 (c) The commission may provide training services to
1-36 counties on the use and operation of a system created, operated, or
1-37 maintained by one or more counties under Subsection (a).

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
