4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 42.0421, Human Resources Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
7	(e) The training required by this section must be provided
8	by a person who:
9	(1) is a training provider registered with the Texas
10	Early Care and Education Career Development System's Texas Trainer
11	Registry that is maintained by the Texas Head Start State
12	<u>Collaboration Office;</u>
13	(2) is an instructor at a public or private secondary
14	school or at a public or private institution of higher education, as
15	defined by Section 61.801, Education Code, who teaches early
16	childhood development or another relevant course, as determined by
17	rules adopted by the commissioner of education and the commissioner
18	of higher education;
19	(3) is an employee of a state agency with relevant
20	<u>expertise;</u>
21	(4) is a physician, psychologist, licensed
22	professional counselor, social worker, or registered nurse;
23	(5) holds a generally recognized credential, such as a
24	certification to provide instruction in cardiopulmonary

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1	resuscitation; or
2	(6) is a registered family home care provider or
3	director of a day-care center in good standing with the department,
4	if applicable, and is only providing training at the home or center
5	where the provider or director and the person receiving training
6	are employed, provided that the department has not taken an action
7	against the provider's license, listing, or registration under
8	Section 42.071, 42.072, or 42.078 during the two-year period
9	preceding the date on which the provider or director provides the
10	training.
11	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
