## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to insurance coverage for certain devices that facilitate
3	insulin therapy and enhance glucose control in the treatment of
4	diabetes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subdivisions (1) and (2), Section 1358.051,
7	Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows:
8	(1) "Diabetes equipment" means:
9	(A) blood glucose monitors, including
10	noninvasive glucose monitors and glucose monitors designed to be
11	used by blind individuals;
12	(B) insulin pumps and associated appurtenances;
13	(C) insulin infusion devices and devices that
14	facilitate insulin therapy and enhance glucose control; and
15	(D) podiatric appliances for the prevention of
16	complications associated with diabetes.
17	(2) "Diabetes supplies" means:
18	(A) test strips for blood glucose monitors;
19	(B) visual reading and urine test strips;
20	(C) lancets and lancet devices;
21	(D) insulin and insulin analogs;
22	(E) injection aids <u>and devices that facilitate</u>
23	insulin therapy and enhance glucose control;
24	(F) syringes;

S.B. No. 64 1 (G) prescriptive and nonprescriptive oral agents 2 for controlling blood sugar levels; and (H) glucagon emergency kits. 3 4 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an insurance policy that 5 is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2010. A policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before 6 7 January 1, 2010, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in 8 9 effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
