| 1-12 | SECTION 1. Subdivisions (1) and (2), Section 1358.051, |
| 1-13 | Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows: |
| 1-14 | (1) "Diabetes equipment" means: |
| 1-15 | (A) blood glucose monitors, including |
| 1-16 | noninvasive glucose monitors and glucose monitors designed to be |
| 1-17 | used by blind individuals; |
| 1-18 | (B) insulin pumps and associated appurtenances; |
| 1-19 | (C) insulin infusion devices and devices that |
| 1-20 | facilitate insulin therapy and enhance glucose control; and |
| 1-21 | (D) podiatric appliances for the prevention of |
| 1-22 | complications associated with diabetes. |
| 1-23 | (2) "Diabetes supplies" means: |
