- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 531.0105 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 531.0105. LIMITATION ON PAID LEAVE FOR CERTAIN HEALTH
- 9 AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY EMPLOYEES. (a) The administrative head
- of the commission or a health and human services agency may grant
- 11 leave without a deduction in salary to an agency employee while the
- 12 agency performs a criminal history background check on the
- 13 <u>employee</u>.
- 14 (b) The total amount of leave an employee may be granted
- 15 under this section may not exceed 30 days during a state fiscal
- 16 biennium.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
