13	job responsibilities.
14	(b) Not later than the 30th day after the date an employee of
15	a health and human services agency assumes new job
16	responsibilities, the employee shall complete any required
17	training relating to those responsibilities.
18	Sec. 531.0092. EXIT INTERVIEWS FOR HEALTH AND HUMAN
19	SERVICES AGENCY EMPLOYEES. Each health and human services agency
20	shall inform an employee that terminates employment with the agency

23	Sec. 531.0093. NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF HEALTH AND HUMAN

3	the employee's termination to the paymaster of the agency.
